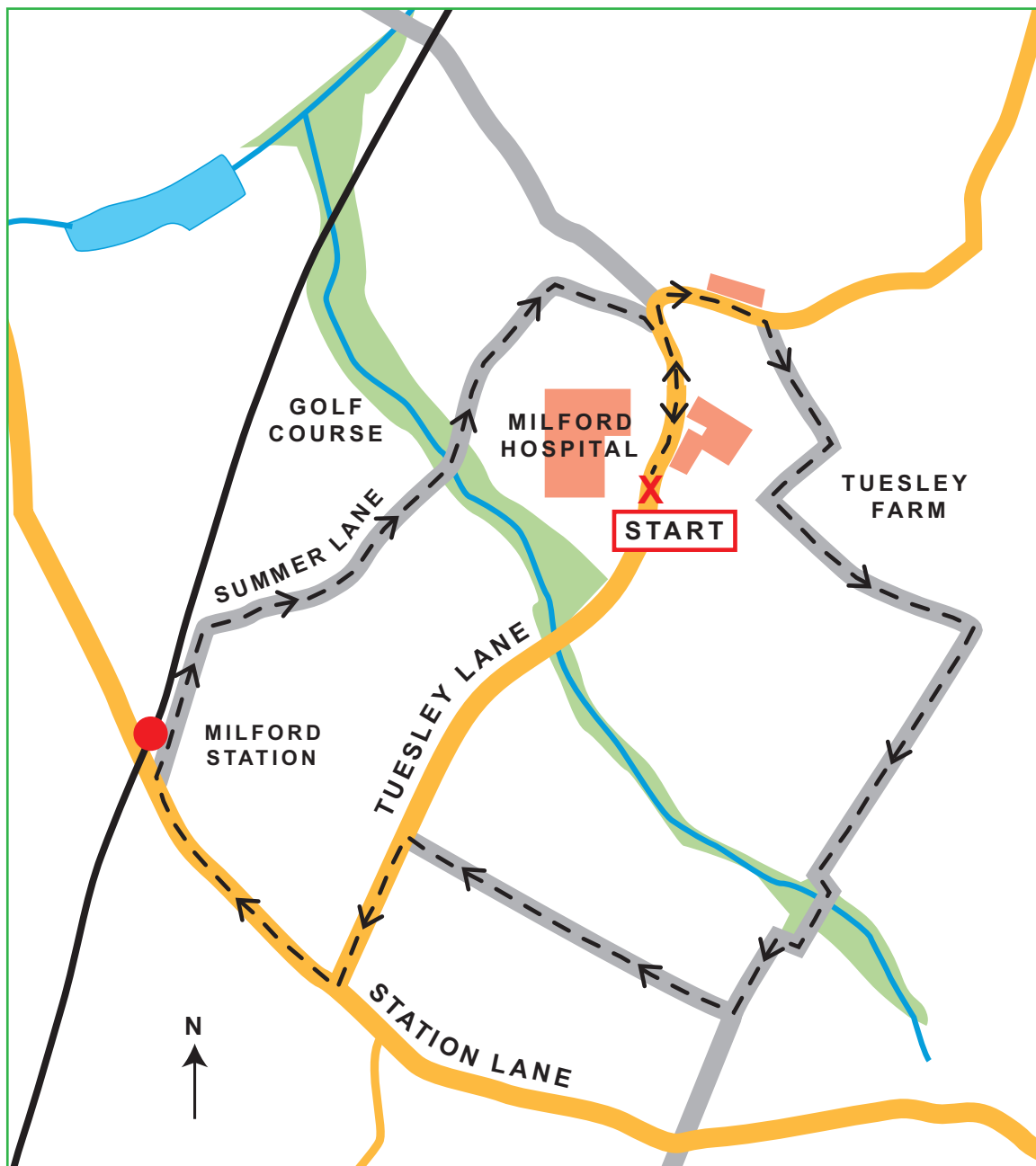









# Walk 1

## Summer Soft Fruits Trail – Milford Station & Tuesley Farm

**Start:** Tuesley Lane – lay-by beside Milford Hospital

# Walk 1

## Summer Soft Fruits Trail – Milford Station & Tuesley Farm

### Directions

Walk northwards along Tuesley Lane, taking care on the bends as you begin to descend, until you reach a house with a dovecote on your left. Take the footpath off to the right up some steps and take care not to trip over an old broken down stile at the top. Continue ahead, passing a pond on your left and a hedge on your right. Turn right at the end of the hedge.

You are now walking through Tuesley Farm and you can see, close up, the farm's soft fruit industry including strawberries, raspberries and blueberries. Follow the well-signed footpath through the farm, ignoring farm tracks off the signposted route, until you reach a small copse. Follow the signpost left but after 30 yards turn right through a wooden kissing gate passing a seat on the other side.

When you emerge from the copse at another wooden kissing gate turn right for about 30 yards and then turn left. Continue ahead and shortly ignore the signpost directing left. Watch for a signpost going right stating 'the Tuesley Farm Community Path' and follow this signposted route to Tuesley Lane.

When you emerge on to Tuesley Lane cross the road and turn left on the path. At the T-junction turn right and walk to Milford Station. Just before the level crossing, turn right to walk along the lane, a private road but also a public footpath. The railway line and then the golf course are on your left.

After you pass a cottage on your left, the footpath keeps straight ahead and narrows, first descending a little, then climbing through a gully. The path passes the new housing development on the right. *(The footpath is currently diverted, April 2015, whilst the development is taking place. When the development is finished please follow the designated path out to Tuesley Lane.)* Continue straight on the path to a T junction and turn right to shortly reach Tuesley Lane. Turn right to retrace your steps back to your starting point.
