

**THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL
PETWORTH ROAD (A283), WITLEY
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2017**

Dear Sirs

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSE TO MAKE the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Petworth Road (A283), Witley that extends from its junction with Mill Lane (D150) to its junction with Culmer Lane (D169). This Temporary Traffic Order is required to enable highway resurfacing and/or maintenance works on behalf of Surrey County Council. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 09:00 and 16:30, as soon as possible within the eighteen month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order that commences on 3rd April 2017. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access will be maintained for pedestrians and emergency vehicles at all times. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses wherever reasonably possible and advanced notification will be given however in the event that it is necessary to restrict any access at any time under Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the road can only be closed for a maximum of 8 hours in any 24-hour period. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner. Southbound vehicular traffic will be diverted north from the northern point of closure via Petworth Road (A283) towards Milford to take the first exit at the roundabout onto the Haslemere Road (A286) to continue on the A286 towards Brook then Grayswood Road (A286) towards Haslemere and High Street Haslemere (A286), turning left onto the Petworth Road (B2131) towards Lythe Hill then Rodgate Lane (B2131), then turning left onto Petworth Road (A283) towards Chiddingfold to continue on the A283 towards Wormley and the southern point of the closure. From the southern point of closure, northbound vehicular traffic will be diverted north from the A283 Wormley to follow the diversion described above in reverse through the High Street Haslemere one way gyratory.
